

Information on the processing of personal data for individuals who contact Revpack

Data controller

The controller of your personal data provided by you when contacting us is Marcin Uchacz operating under the business name "Marcin Uchacz Business Consulting", Fabryczna 4a/11, 00-446 Warsaw (Poland), NIP: 7011050577.

Whenever you need to contact us in the matters related to the processing of your personal data, you can do so by sending us an email at marcin@revpack.co.

Purposes of processing personal data

We will process your personal data in order to answer your questions related to our business activity as well as to present you offers, if we are asked to do so and exchange ongoing correspondence.

Legal basis for processing personal data

The legal basis for the processing of your personal data is our legitimate interest (Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR), which consists in being able to establish and maintain our business relations, including to provide answers to the questions about our business activity, to present offers, to exchange correspondence.

Obligation to provide personal data

You are not obliged to provide us with your personal data, but without them, unfortunately, we will not be able to contact you back, and in particular to answer your questions.

Retention period

We will store your personal data no longer than for the period of maintaining our current relations (e.g. answering questions, presenting offers, exchanging correspondence), and after that time for the period and to the extent necessary to renew our contact (up to 24 months).

Your rights related to processing of personal data

You have the right to:

- access your data and receive a copy of it,
- rectify your data, delete it or limit its processing
- receive your data and transmit it to another controller or request, if technically possible, to have it transmitted directly to another data controller – where the processing is based on consent, on a contract or carried out by automated means, and
- where the processing is based on your consent – withdraw your consent at any time, which, however, will not affect the lawfulness of the processing based on the basis of your consent before its withdrawal.

You also have the right to object to the processing of your data due to your particular situation – where the processing is based on our legitimate interest.

To exercise any of those rights, please contact us (for contact details see section „Data controller”).

Right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority

If you find that the processing of your personal data is contrary to the law, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority – which in Poland is the President of the Personal Data Protection Office.

Data recipients

The recipients of your personal data may be entities providing services to us, including IT services, legal services, as well as entities authorized to obtain data on the basis of applicable law – only in cases and to the extent necessary to answer your questions related to our business activity, as well as to present you offers, if we are asked to do so and exchange ongoing correspondence.

Transfer of personal data to third countries or international organisations

We will not transfer your personal data to third countries (i.e. outside the European Economic Area) or to international organizations.

Automated decision-making

We will not make decisions in relation to you in an automated manner.
